1. A copy of SIG 1 and DA Pam 310-21 should be available to every user of the Signal portion of the Army supply manual.

a. SIG 1 explains the purpose and use of the Signal portion of the Army supply manual.

b. DA Pam 310-21 contains alphabetical and numerical indexes of available manuals in the Signal portion of the Army supply manual.

2. Items marked X under expendability note are expendable within the meaning of AR 735-4; nonexpendable items are marked NX.

3. A percent symbol indicates the item is authorized for use in the category of maintenance indicated and may be requisitioned when required. Not authorized for stockage.

4. The Federal stock number column lists the 11-digit Federal stock number assigned by the Cataloging Division, OASD (S & L). In the absence of a Federal stock number the Signal Corps stock number will be used for requisitioning purposes.

5. Repair parts source, maintenance and recoverability code symbols annotated in the

description column after ea. provide information on the use and availability of repair parts according to their functional application. The following are repair parts code definitions in accordance with AR 700-18:

a. *Part I.* Technical service supply sources code 11 indicates a stocked Signal Corps support part. Refer to AR 310-2 for technical service number.

b. *Part II.* The most efficient and practical source or method of supply for the part.

(1) Code "P" — applied to repair parts which are high consumption parts; procured by technical services, stocked in and supplied from the technical service depot system, and authorized for installation at indicated maintenance echelons.

(2) Code "P1" — applied to repair parts which are low consumption parts; procured by technical services, stocked only in and supplied from technical service key depots, and authorized for installation at indicated maintenance echelons.

c. *Part III.* The lowest echelon of maintenance capable of installing or manufacturing the part.

- (1) "O" — Organizational Maintenance (1st and 2d echelon).
- (2) "F" — Field Maintenance (3d echelon).
- (3) "H" — Field Maintenance (4th echelon).
- (4) "D" — Depot Maintenance (5th echelon).

d. *Part IV.* The recoverability aspects of the part will be listed only when applicable.

- (1) Code "R" — Repairable — are repair parts which are economically repairable and when available, are furnished by supply on an exchange basis.
- (2) Code "S" — Salvageable — are repair parts which may be placed in "Ready for Issue" condition by cleaning, replating, anodizing, adjusting, welding, etc.

6. SIG 7 & 8 BD-95 comprises three parts as follows:

a. *Stock Number List.* A list of all stock numbers in the Maintenance Items portion arranged in stock number sequence and cross-referenced to page numbers to facilitate compliance with SB 11-190.

b. *Maintenance Items.* A list of parts for repair and supply facilities.

c. *Basic Issue Items.* A list of component parts showing the quantities of each that comprise a complete operating equipment, including running spares, that is, those spare parts shipped concurrently with the equipment and accessories.

7. Any comments concerning omissions and discrepancies in this manual will be prepared on DA Form 2028 and forwarded direct to Commanding Officer, U. S. Army Signal Equipment Support Agency, Fort Monmouth, N. J., ATTN: SIGFM/ES-ML.
