2. Items marked X under expendability note are expendable within the meaning of AR 735-4; nonexpendable items are marked NX.
3. A dagger (†) in the designation by model column indicates the model in which the part is used.
4. A percent symbol (%) indicates the item is authorized for use in the category of maintenance indicated and may be requisitioned when required. Not authorized for stockage.
5. The Federal stock number column lists the 11-digit Federal stock number assigned by the Cataloging Division, OASD (S&L). The Federal

stock number will be used for requisitioning purposes.

6. This manual reflects the results of physical review of the equipment covered herein. Refer to TB SIG 305.

7. SIG 7 & 8 HS-25 comprises two parts as follows:


- a. *Maintenance Items.* A list of parts for repair and supply facilities.
- b. *Basic Issue Items.* A list of component parts showing the quantities of each that comprise a complete operating equipment, including running spares, that is, those spare parts shipped concurrently with the equipment, and accessories.
